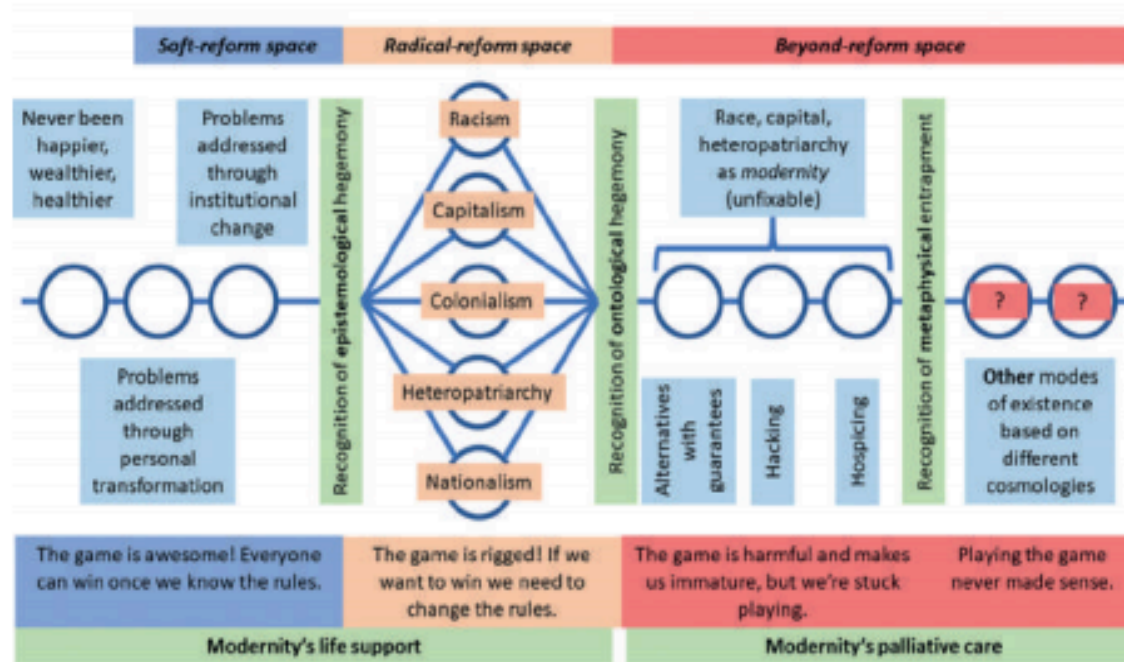


Figure 1: Soft reform, radical reform and beyond reform spaces (adapted from Andreotti *et al.* 2015)²
